**RESOLUTION NO. 63 S. 2020**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NETWORK OF CYCLING LANES AND WALKING PATHS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUMBAN TO SUPPORT PEOPLE’S MOBILITY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 447 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Bayan as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, paragraph 5(v) of the same Section states, that the primary duty and function of the Sanggunian is to approve ordinances which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code, and in addition to said services is the regulation of the streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, park and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Mayors and Local Sanggunians were directed by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) through Memorandum Circular No. 2020-100 dated July 17, 2020 to establish a network of cycling lanes and walking paths to support people’s mobility;

**WHEREAS**, the National Transport Policy of the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) encourages Local Government Units (LGUs) to accord highest priority to the development of proper sidewalks and networks of bicycle lanes to promote a more sustainable and inclusive transport system that encourages active transport, and provides safe and direct access the priority services wherein, through careful planning and adoption of appropriate strategies, the shift of mobility mode to walking and cycling may significantly decrease the vehicular volume, minimize traffic congestions in major roads and highways, and improve urban air quality levels through reduced transport emissions;

**WHEREAS**, it is imperative that the Municipality of Lumban together with the entire country to prepare for the “New Normal” amid the COVID-19 pandemic wherein the use of

bicycles and walking have been promoted as essential and safer modes of transport as this allows physical distancing and provides the needed mobility for citizens to proceed with their daily activities;

**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the LGUs powers to promote health and safety and preserve the comfort and convenient of its inhabitants in conformity with the existing guidelines issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and other national government agencies, the Municipal Government of Lumban must implement the establishment of a network of cycling lanes and walking paths to support people's mobility in all of its thoroughfares;



**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to approve the establishment of a network of cycling lanes and walking paths within the Municipality of Lumban to support people's mobility;

**APPROVED**, this 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2020.


