RESOLUTION NO. 70 S. 2022

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR, HON. RAMIL L. HERNANDEZ THROUGH THE LAGUNA TOURISM, CULTURE, ARTS AND TRADE OFFICE (LTCATO), FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A MARKER STATING THE LUMBANG TREE PLANTED AT THE CHURCH'S PATIO AS THE OLDEST SPECIMEN IN THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS, the Lumbang tree at the church's patio is one of the oldest specimens of Lumbang tree in the town, planted on October 4, 1978 by the students of Lumban Academy to mark and commemorate the quadricentennial jubilee of the town of Lumban as civil entity;

WHEREAS, this specific specimen of Lumbang tree or the *Aleuritestrilobus* reflects the rich ancient trading relationship between the ancient China and the Philippines for this particular variety of Lumbang tree was believed to be originated from mainland China and brought in Laguna by the Chinese traders who settled in the province and planted the tree more abundantly in the place where presently known as Lumban;

WHEREAS, the Lumbang tree in the church's patio is a specimen that can be used to illustrate and to visualize how the ancient Lumbeños used the extracted rich oil from the seed to illuminate their homes, to fuel their earthen stoves and to cure illness;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Lumban strongly believe that the 44 year old tree must be introduced to the coming generations through the help of the Provincial Government and the LTCATO for this specimen could serve as a bridge that will link the past to the present and to the future.

NOW THEREFORE, on the motion of Hon. Mark Anthony L. Lagrosa, duly seconded by Hon. John Dember A. Delos Reyes, and with the concurrence of all members present it was;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to approve the resolution requesting the Provincial Governor, Hon. Ramil L. Hernandez through the Laguna Tourism, Culture, Arts and Trade Office (LTCATO), for the installation of a marker stating the Lumbang Tree planted at the Church's Patio as the oldest specimen in the municipality.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to transmit copy of this resolution to the Office of the Provincial Governor, the Laguna Tourism, Culture, Arts and Trade Office (LTCATO) and other concern offices for their information and appropriate action.


